Colour and Space in Cultural Heritage (COSCH) is an interdisciplinary network of experts in and users of the latest optical measuring techniques and imaging used in documentation of artefacts. COSCH networking activities are funded by **COST**, an intergovernmental framework for European Cooperation in Science and Technology. Funding has been made available for four years, from 2012 to 2016. It enables coordination on a European level of nationally-funded research. COSCH has been joined by some 200 interdisciplinary researchers representing 26 COST countries.
